

Bringing a Cat?

ELIGIBILITY AND APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED

You must call 360-733-6549 for eligibility & scheduling before bringing an animal through WeSNiP's program.

The location for Check-In and Pick-Up is:

The WeSNiP Office PARKING LOT : 2505 Cedarwood Avenue in Bellingham
(office building next door to Grant's Burgers. WeSNiP signage will be at the parking lot)

Due to COVID-19, check-in and pick-up will take place in the parking lot. PLEASE STAY IN YOUR CAR and a WeSNiP staff member or volunteer will assist you.

- **Drive-Through Check-In and Curbside Pick-Up**
- **Check-In and Pick-Up can each take up to 30 minutes, once you arrive.**

You will be given your check-in and pick-up time when your cat's appointment is scheduled and a reminder will be given the day before your cat's appointment.

Other Appointment Reminders:

- **Have your cat/s securely in their crate/s (one cat per crate) when you arrive to Check-In**, with only a clean towel inside the crate for bedding (or the bedding we provided if you borrowed a loaner crate).
 - Covering the crate with a towel or cover for the drive to & from their appointment, may help keep your cat calm.
 - **No** food, water or other belongings inside your cat's crate when you bring them to check-in.
- **For all cats, all food should be removed by midnight the night before surgery.**
 - **They can have access to water up until the appointment**
- **For outdoor or indoor/outdoor cats**, we strongly recommend bringing them inside by the evening before surgery.
- **Prepare a smaller room, where the cats can recover in a warm, dry, quiet area for ideally 48 hours after surgery.** Cats in the same household may not recognize each other right away, so separate recovery spaces is best.
- Our **recommended donation** is \$55 for each cat. This covers WeSNiP's out-of-pocket cost for this service & we need donations to be able to continue to offer our services to the community. WeSNiP is a donations-driven program so every dollar counts and donations are strongly encouraged.
